Congratulations! You're getting ready to graduate from high school, and to move on to the next phase of your education. Applying for this scholarship is a great idea – a little extra help paying for your education always comes in handy!

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Up to \$1,500 per year, renewable for up to 4 years (you must maintain a 2.5 GPA each year)

WHO CAN GET THE SCHOLARSHIP?

Students graduating from Harwood Union, Lamoille Union, People's Academy and Stowe High School, and students from those high schools attending Central Vermont Career Center or Green Mountain Tech Center are eligible to apply.

This scholarship is for current high school seniors, graduating in June 2017, who are:

- Planning to attend an accredited technical training program, OR
 - Planning to attend college in 2017-2018.
 - Able to demonstrate financial need.*
 - Students attending colleges or programs in Vermont will be given special consideration.
- * Wondering what "financial need" means? Well, it's all relative— but generally, if your annual household income is under \$80,000, or your EFC is less than \$15,000, you are more likely to qualify for this scholarship.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Here are the instructions for applying for the Alchemist Opportunity Fund Scholarship.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED:

1. The two-page Application Form
2. A copy of your transcript (which you would get from the Guidance Department).
3. The last page (confirmation page) of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>) showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
4. The statement provided by your school showing your cost of attendance and financial aid and merit awards (cost of attendance documentation plus financial aid award).

Three (3) Recommendations:

5. One from a teacher
6. One from a community member (not family)
7. One from a friend of yours

Put it all together and assemble by May 10!

To the Scholarship Applicants:

Mt Mansfield Masonic Lodge, located in Jericho, Vermont annually awards scholarships in the amount of \$500 to high school seniors to assist them in continuing their educational endeavors at accredited two- or four-year colleges, community colleges, technical schools or accredited trade schools. Scholarships may be used for any bona fide school expense such as tuition, fees, and books. A maximum of three scholarships will be awarded.

This scholarship is open to all students completing their senior year at Lamoille Union High School, Mt Mansfield Union High School, and Winooski High School. It is also open to home schooled students residing within the boundaries of the three school districts. The application must be submitted no later than April 15th of your year of graduation. Applicants need not have Masonic affiliation nor are they restricted by race, creed, color, sex, handicap, or national origin. All graduating seniors are highly encouraged to apply.

The members of the Scholarship Selection Committee will not personally meet you and will only have this application by which to judge your submission. Consider carefully the content and completeness of your responses to the information being sought. A broad-based criterion is used in the selection process, including an applicant's academic record, financial need, extra curricular activities, community service, and leadership. The organization, appearance, and completeness of your application are also factors considered by the selection committee.

You may complete this application in pen, typewriter, or computer. A copy of the application can also be downloaded from the Mt Mansfield Lodge website. Please ensure that your handwriting is legible. Please submit a copy of your transcript and a school profile along with your application, this can be a scanned or a photocopy, however transcript content will be validated with school officials. Any alterations to misrepresent your academic accomplishments will result in disqualification.
